1	Refer to the attached "Schedule and Offer" please kindly advise if we have to include fee for fitness facilities products at this tender submission stage, thanks.	Please note that it is not necessary to include fee for fitness facilities products at this stage.
2	May I refer to paras. 14 and 17 of the tender specifications document, regarding the requirement on the design of the facilities and its actual production. Para. 14 set out that the actual production of the technology and the product is not necessary, whilst para. 17 indicates the qualification of the consultancy team that has to be 'qualified' in technology application.  Grateful for indication on whether the requirement of IoT experitise is a must for the consultancy team or could be optional at this design stage as the IT application of the facilities can be further developed at a later stage after the consultancy design stage.	Thank you for your interest in our Design Consultancy Study.  Requirement of IoT knowledge in the team is optional at this stage. You just need to demonstrate that you have the bandwidth to understand and achieve the objectives of this R+D led action research and project. Nonetheless, you should tell us your initial thoughts on the sort of IoT and Technology that you would like to integrate in the proposal to promote IG play, wellness management and any other objectives identified in the tender and highlight how you intend to seek these specialist input to develop your proposed scheme.
