Category	Positive	Improvements
(1) Comfort and appearance of the public open space	Clean environment	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Unconformable seating • Poor anti-mosquito measures and mosquitoes traps are needed • Unrepaired facilities such as broken and rusty handrail • Uneven road surface
(2) Access and linkages to reach the public open space	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Good accessibility to public transport 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Unclear signage and guidelines • More descriptive information should be given • Insufficient lighting along the trail • A more welcoming entrance is recommended because there are not many people know this trail • Accesses are not prominent and unable to provide clear direction

3.1 Users' activities	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Chatting • Exercising (i.e. Kung Fu exercise, running) • Sitting • Resting 	
3.2 Improper use of facilities	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Unclear instruction • Original purpose of facilities cannot be achieved • Kids play the fitness equipment inappropriately 	
3.3 Unable to fulfill the needs of users	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Facilities' height is not suitable for someone 	
3.4 Unattractive design of facilities	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Suggested to be replaced with equipment in attractive colour and special texture 	
3.5 Security concern	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No CCTV along the trail • More lighting should be added to enhance a higher visibility and increase sense of security • The trail is concealed by lush plants and this increases the risk of crime 	
Highlight in workshop- (i) Safety concern	<p><i>Response from participants:</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Uneven road surface • Insufficient lighting 	
Highlight in workshop- (ii) Storage	<p><i>Response from participants:</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Lack of storage space (people hang their belongings with a pin on the shelter) 	

Highlight in workshop- (iii) Greening	<i>Response from participants:</i>
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Inadequate flowers • Lack of smell to attract people
Highlight in workshop- (iv) Use of technology	<i>Response from participants:</i>
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Integrate equipment with mobile apps • Making use of QR code or AI
Considerations of Intergeneration	<i>Engagement:</i>
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No gym facilities for children or the disable • Existing exercise equipment tend to attract adult/ female young-old
	<i>Safety:</i>
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The track is too steep - hard for runners/ elderly/ disable to walk • Non-slipped floor surface is suggested to be applied on the inclined path • Uneven ground in some exercise facilities • Elderly may not know how to use the fitness facilities properly (unclear instructions)
Considerations of Intergeneration	<i>Interaction</i>
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No interaction between users • Not enough space for children to play with parents • Poor seating arrangement that does not facilitate interaction • The necessary of separating different zones should be considered
